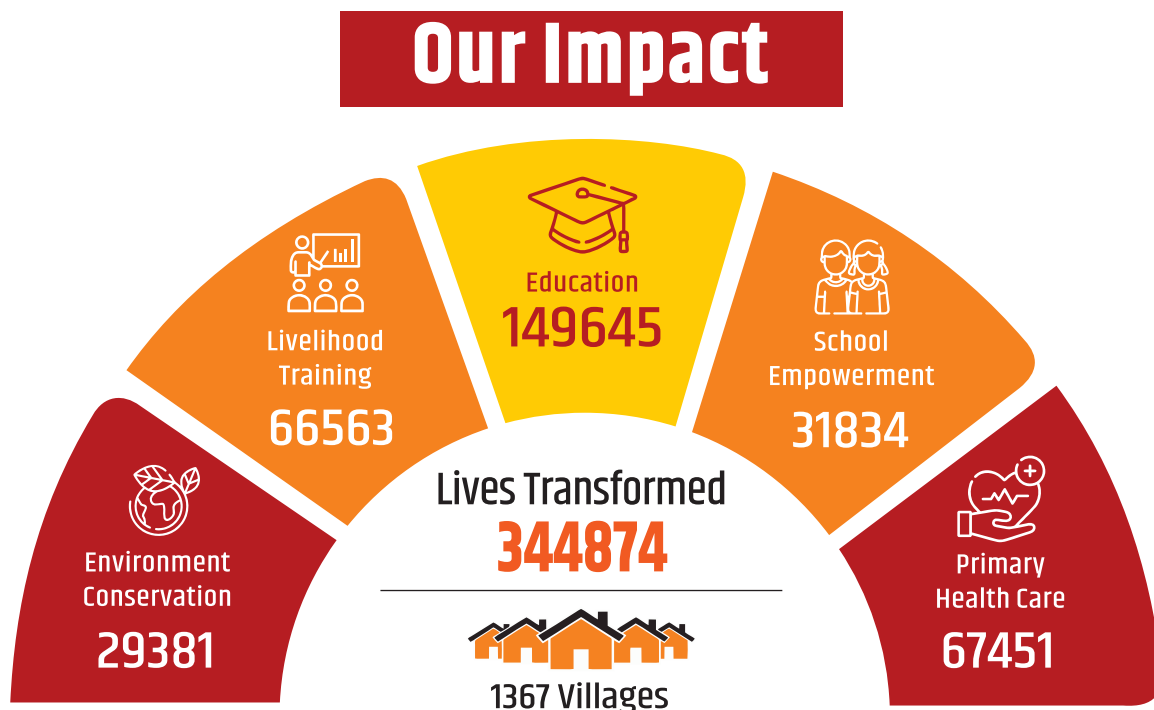

As a purpose-led organisation, Light of Life Trust is poised to scale new heights in the year ahead.



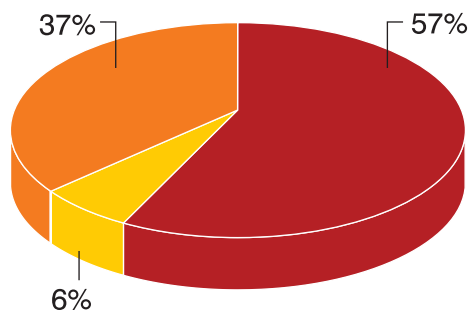
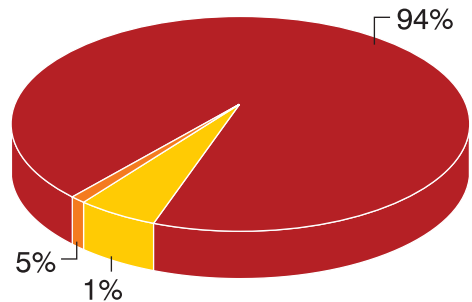

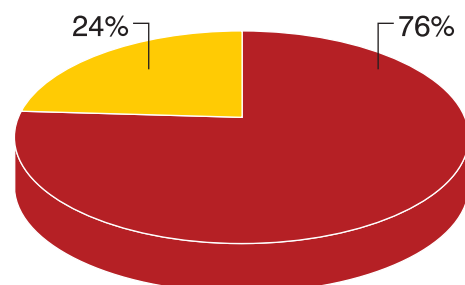


Donation Type

Donation Break Up

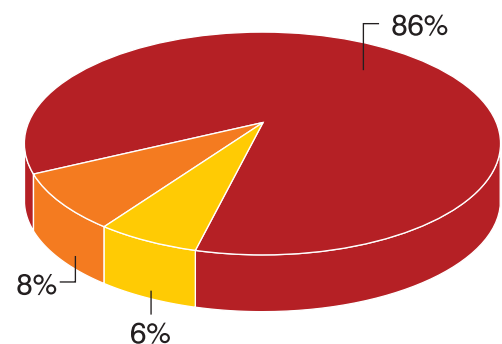

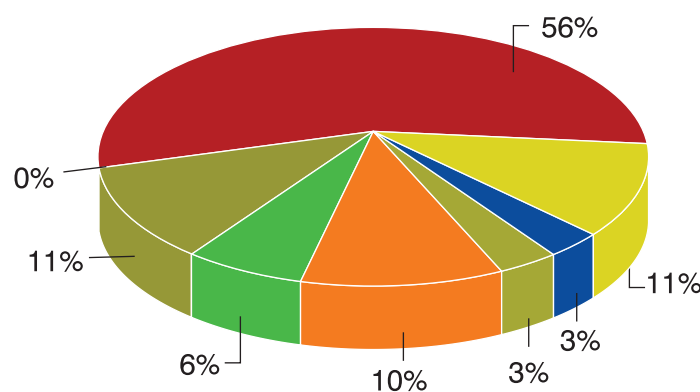

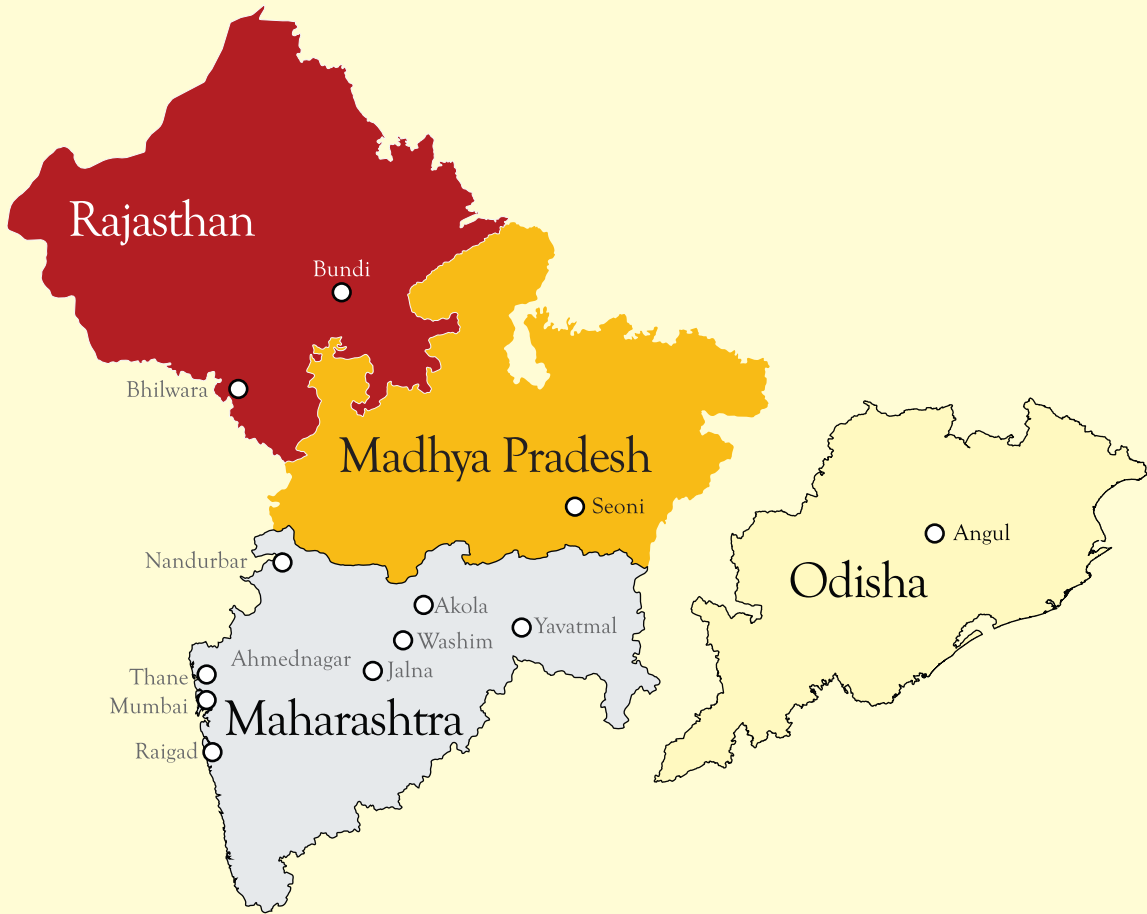
