### Inauguration of Dental Unit & Medical Mobile Unit App

On 5th December 2019, a Dental unit was inaugurated in the presence of Ms. Kamal Damania, COO – Light of Life Trust, Dr. Dheeraj – HOD & Dr. Renu – Tutor and team of Yerla Medical Trust Dental College and Hospital and Mr. Gautam Kanoje, APM – Jagruti, at Jeevan Asha Community Centre, Tiwari, Karjat. The Dental unit is setup in collaboration with Yerla Medical Trust Dental College and Hospital and will cater to all Dental needs of the local community including the nearby Raigad Zilla Parishad students. On this occasion the MMU App was also launched to digitally maintain data of patients / beneficiaries reached by the MMU units in Karjat & Murbad.



### Creation of Children Manifesto

As a part of a joint effort by various child rights organizations and groups working with children, an initiative was taken to create a children's manifesto and present it to local MLAs before the Lok Sabha Elections in Mumbai in October 2019. Four children from Worli centre participated in this process along with children from different settlements of the city to brainstorm on civic and other issues specifically faced by children. These efforts culminated in a Press Conference held at Mumbai Marathi Patraakar Sangh, at CST. Our student Riya Mali was selected as one of the panelists on the dais and got an opportunity to present her group's views in front of the forum as well as answer questions posed by the press and journalists present in the audience. This was a great exposure for the children to learn about larger processes of local democracy.

The programme brought together children and child rights activists from across different parts of Maharashtra. A training session to familiarize the children with the report was also undertaken.
