

Plantation through the Miyawaki approach under Project Jagruti.



Light of Life Trust Medical Mobile Unit



Under the Jal Sanjeevani Week celebrated across India from 23rd to 29th July, 2018 Light of Life Trust through its Medical Mobile Unit in partnership with Indian Academy of Pediatricians, Karjat, Raigad District, and Karjat Medical Association organised an Awareness camp on contaminated water and the source of water borne diseases such as Diarrhea, Cholera, Typhoid gastro etc., alongwith inputs on prevention of these diseases. ORS (Oral Rehydration Salts) and their use in treatment of water borne diseases were also explained to the villagers.

Breast feeding awareness week was also organized on 23rd August 2018 in Karjat, Raigad District in association with Raigad Medical Association.

Environment Conservation Programme, Karjat Taluka

Light of Life Trust through its Environment Conversation Programme in collaboration with All Cargo Logistics Ltd has distributed over 1,42,347 fruit bearing plants to 3440 farmers across 111 villages in Karjat Taluka, Raigad District of Maharashtra over the last four years. This year 28,650 plants were distributed in the month of August to 560 new farmers.







Medical Mobile Unit - Pune Launch

The services of the second Medical Mobile Unit were launched in collaboration with KEMHRC, Pune on 19th September 2018. The medical van will cater to the needs of the population in Junnar, Ambegaon, and Rajgurunagar in Pune District.
