# Capacity Building & Singing Workshop by 'ARTSCAPE'

ARTSCAPE in collaboration with Flowering Tree Inc., USA and Light of Life Trust conducted Expressive Arts Therapy sessions for LOLT students in the Karjat Taluka, Raigad District of Maharashtra state. These sessions will help to develop the physical and emotional capacity of the students.

A special vocal singing session for Anant students by Artscape strengthen singing techniques and methods of developing voice culture and quality of the students learning vocal music during the Anant programme.



#### **Plant Distribution Programme**

Light of Life Trust in collaboration with All Cargo Logistics organized plant distribution activity under its Environment Conservation Programme. In this year 30,000 fruit bearing saplings were distributed to 600 new tribal farmers from 24 villages.

In total through this programme LOLT is reaching out to 4040 farmers across 127 villages having distributed 1,72,347 fruit saplings to farmers in Karjat.



### **Mega Medical Camp**

Light of Life Trust in partnership with Nair Super Speciality Eye Hospital & Terna Medical College & Hospital conducted screening camps for school and college teachers, staff and ex-members of Dnyan Mandir High School, Karjat.

The Terna Medical College & Hospital conducted screening camps in Cardiac test, ENT test, Orthopedic test, Blood pressure test, Blood sugar level test, ECG test & Bone densitometry test. The Eye screening camp was organized by Nair Super Speciality Eye Hospital.
